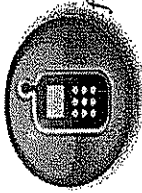

Washington state law defines sexual intercourse involving someone under the age of 16 as "rape of a child," rather than statutory rape. Degrees are based on age rather than level of force.
